









Highlights 28 Sep-03 Oct 2022

- The National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) has enrolled nine seminal matters as part of its constitutional mandate to take decisive and visible action against high-level corruption and state capture. The National Director of Public Prosecutions made the announcement during the NPA's briefing to Parliament's Portfolio Committee in March 2022. Anti-Corruption Headlines 04-10 Oct 2022

- Six people were arrested by the Hawks and appeared in the Nelspruit Magistrate's Court on 5 October 2022 for corruption and money laundering related to COVID-19 Personal Protective Equipment in the Mpumalanga Department of Public Works, Roads and Transport. The SIU investigations uncovered evidence of fraud, corruption and money laundering between the officials and service providers amounting to approximately R1.3 million.
- A Pretoria magistrate has appeared at the Pretoria Specialised Commercial Crimes Court on 10 October 2022 on charges of corruption linked to African Global or Global Technology Systems (BOSASA).

Anti-Corruption Headlines 11-17 Oct 2022

- The Hawks have arrested five officials involved in a R60 million vehicle licensing fraud ring in Delmas, Piet Retief and Lydenburg, respectively. So far, 14 people have been arrested.
- Thohoyandou Magistrates' former prosecutor has been convicted of corruption after demanding R6 000 to make a case disappear instead of referring it to the Child Justice Court.

Highlights 18 -24 October 2022

President Ramaphosa presented his response to the State Capture Commission recommendations during a public address that highlighted:

- Granting of R12.9 billion freezing and preservation orders;
- Recovery of R2.9 billion funds;
- Collection of R4.8 billion in uncollected taxes by SARS;
- Enrollment of 26 state capture cases and 189 investigations declared by the Independent Directorate of the NPA
- Court appearance of 165 people for corruption.

Anti-Corruption Headlines 25-31 Oct 2022

- Pooven Chetty and Associates Inc., trading as Umnotho Development has been fined R5 million and further ordered to pay back R19.2 million. The High Court found that the funds were irregularly received from the Eastern Cape Department of Social Development.
- The SIU has obtained a preservation order from the Special Tribunal (court) to freeze pension benefits of Limpopo Department of Health's Head of Department. The order interdicts and restrains the Government Employees Pension Fund from paying out or transferring any benefits.
