WESTERN CAPE INHERITED DEBT RELIEF BILL

*(As introduced in the National Assembly (proposed section 77))
(The English text is the official text of the Bill)*

(MINISTER OF FINANCE)

[B 6—2009]

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BILL

To authorise the discharge of certain debts of the former Cape Provincial Administration and the former House of Representatives, which have devolved upon the Western Cape Province in terms of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993, and are still outstanding; to make arrangements for the settling of accounts in relation to the debts; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Definitions

1. In this Act, except if inconsistent with the context, “**inherited debt**” means the liabilities incurred on behalf of the former Cape Provincial Administration and the former House of Representatives, which— 5

- (a) in terms of section 239(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993 (Act No. 200 of 1993), or by virtue of any allocation made in terms of that section, devolved upon the Western Cape Province;
- (b) is still outstanding; and 10
- (c) is represented by the amounts as specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Act.

Authorisation of inherited debt

2. (1) The unauthorised expenditure of the former Cape Provincial Administration of R 799 366 196.11, which is specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, is hereby authorised. 15

(2) The unauthorised expenditure of the former House of Representatives of R 112 724 302.23, which is specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, is hereby authorised.

(3) The amounts referred to in subsections (1) and (2) are direct charges against the National Revenue Fund.

Amendment of section 3 of Act 35 of 2000 20

3. Section 3 of the Finance Act, 2000, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words preceding paragraph (a) of the following words:

“The unauthorised expenditure of [R4 139 465 912,82] R3 959 123 269,76 referred to in Schedule 3 which—”.

Amendment of Schedule 3 to Act 35 of 2000 25

4. Schedule 3 to the Finance Act, 2000, is hereby amended by—

- (a) the deletion of the entries and amounts set out in Schedule 2 to this Act; and

- (b) the substitution of the total indicated at the bottom of the first column of Schedule 3, as follows:
“**[R4 139 165 912.82]** R3 959 123 269.76.”.

Short title

5. This Act is called the Western Cape Inherited Debt Relief Act, 2009.
